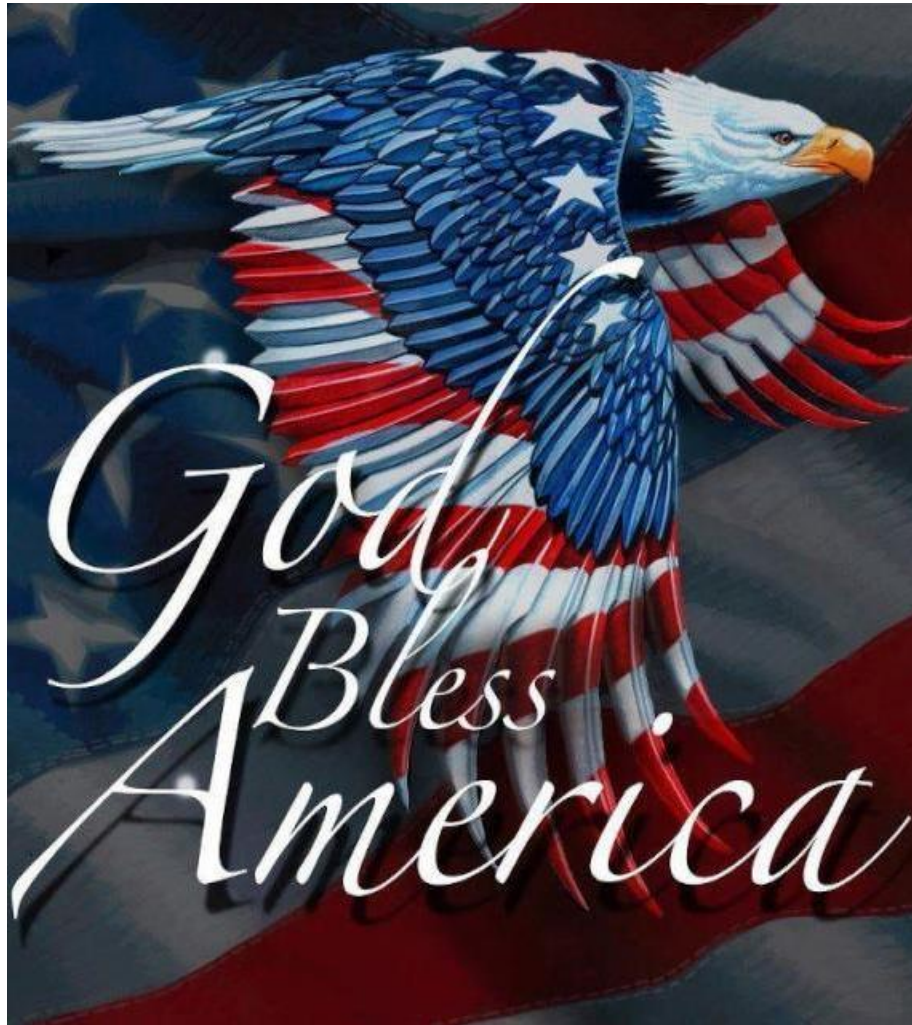

Your most important role is to cover them in prayer: as you consider them, as they attend their weekend, and on their 4th day!
