## Sponsorship

Is Daddy God laying someone on your heart for the upcoming Fall Weekends that you can sponsor? If so, here is a few things to remember as you pray about asking them:

Tres Dias is a community to build up Leaders in the church. Ask yourself, do they have an active relationship with Jesus? If so, talk to them and see if they are even interested in attending a weekend. Make sure they know that it will be a commitment of time away from their family, job, and the world. If they are married, their spouse must also attend. Answer their questions honestly; don't tease or be secretive. Tell them it is a time to be away from the world to be with the Lord to strengthen their relationship with Him. If you would like to bless them with paying their application fee that's wonderful; however, this is not the responsibility of the sponsor. If you are not paying their fees let them know they will have an expense at sendoff. If you are paying their fees, please don't embarrass them at sendoff by not paying.

Some Responsibilities of the Sponsor:

**Palanca** - Collect their palanca letters, and get these letters to the campground or to send off.

**Send off** - Get them to the church for sendoff. If an emergency occurs and they can't attend, please let the pre-weekend couple know as soon as possible.

Look after their family while they are away, and pick your candidate up at closing. COMMUNITY SHOULDN'T BE ON THE CAMPGROUND BEFORE 5:00 PM UNLESS YOU ARE A TEAM MEMBER!

Connect them with a reunion group, bring them to the sequelas, but your most important role is to cover them in prayer: as you consider them, as they attend their weekend, and on their 4th day!

These positions are filled by votes from the Community, so come to the Sequela, and cast your vote! June Sequela-Wakulla Springs on June 10 we'll plan on eating lunch around 12:30 or 1:00 p.m (Lee & I will get there early enough to snag a pavilon) so look for signs. Please bring picnic type food (we will have tea and water). Other things you may want to bring include-lawn chairs, sunscreen, bug spray, swim suits, towels etc. After lunch is free time for swimming, boat rides etc. Come & leave when you want-no set schedule. There will not be any child care available. Be prepared to pay a park entrance fee of at least \$2.00-\$10.00 depending on how many is in the vehicle.
