ANNOUNCEMENT

The Secretariat of North Florida Tres Dias accepted the resignation of Omer Kenworthy as chairman on September 13, 2021, effective immediately. As your Secretariat we want to thank him for his service during this very difficult season. We will continue to operate per the policies and procedures, referenced below, to make sure that all activities of NFTD will continue as planned. We thank you for your prayers; this is an opportunity for us all to serve each other in unity.

Section 4.2.2 says "Any position on the Secretariat vacated by resignation prior to completion of the term shall be appointed by the Secretariat on a two-thirds majority vote. Nominations shall be announced in the Newsletter and solicited from the Community at least 30 days prior to the election. All names submitted by the Community which meet the criteria established in the By-Laws shall be considered. If no candidate receives the two-thirds vote on the first ballot, an elimination ballot will be taken with the two top nominees. Following prayer and discussion, the vote will be taken until a two-thirds majority is achieved.

Palanca: make goodies to be given out throughout the weekend.


Time: Send off, Serenade, Closing. Show support and a picture of the family they are joining.
