

In this month's newsletter, we thought we would share a list of suggested items for candidates to bring for their weekend and other items to leave at home.

Recognizing that we have many first-time sponsors, as well as some returning sponsors who haven't sponsored a candidate in a while, we felt this information might be beneficial. Suggested Items to Bring

- · Comfortable, casual clothes for the season; no dress clothing; lots of sitting and walking throughout the weekend
 - · Personal comfort items
 - Towel/wash cloth/toiletries/shower shoes
- Sheets/blankets (or sleeping bags for bunk beds)
 Pillow
- Jacket/windbreaker; some rooms are cooler than others so you may need to dress in layers
 - · Hangers to hang up towels and clothes
 - · Umbrella (just in case it rains)
 - Flashlight/extra batteries
 - · Personal medications
 - Ear Plugs (for light sleepers)
 - · Bible/Journal
