


Community Spiritual Director

PESCADORE ORIENTATION COORDINATOR

Throughout a Tres Dias weekend there is PRAYER. Prayer is constant and should be used when you decide to SPONSOR someone to attend a weekend. Sponsoring a candidate is a privilege and requires due diligence. A Sponsor is responsible for helping the candidate understand what happens on a weekend and the purpose of Tres Dias. It is a commitment of at least 6 months. This is so Sponsors can help their new Pescadore to attend Victory Breakfast, Victory Sequela, Sequelas, Pescador Orientation and other events involving Tres Dias. Sponsors are responsible for getting love letters from family, friends, mentors and church family for their candidates for their weekend. Sponsors may even have to help with chores, kids and other needs if their candidate is married while they attend their weekend. Sponsors help their candidates to either become a Reunion Group or get involved in a Reunion Group. A Sponsor will explain that there is a fee to attend the weekend.

Sponsoring is NOT just dropping off and picking up a person that attends a weekend. Sponsors do NOT have to pay fee for candidates but it should be discussed and decided who will


pay fee before the weekend.

Practical Pronouncements from the Preweekend Couple

As we transition out of November, the month that is most often associated with thankfulness, and move into December, may we carry over that spirit of gratitude for all that the Lord has done for us. For He has truly been so good to us: "The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works" (Psalm 145:9

When you are considering sponsorship this spring, please keep in mind the following:

- If your potential candidate is married at the time of submitting an application, it is the expectation of the North Florida Tres Dias community that both the husband and the wife attend the same weekend.
 - Candidates who are on a waiting list from the previous weekend are typically offered one of the 36 reserved spots on the upcoming weekend before new potential candidates' applications are reviewed.
- Prior to the start of the Men's Weekend, there are typically six spots available for single men. The remaining thirty spots are initially reserved for married male candidates. However, if there are not thirty married male candidates that have returned their reservation forms by the due date and time to the Preweekend Couple, then the vacant spots may be occupied by single males who have been placed on a waiting list.
- At the conclusion of the Men's Send-Off Ceremony, the Preweekend Couple may then contact any of the single women who have applied and have been put on a waiting list for the possibility of filling any vacant spots for the upcoming Women's Weekend.

"Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift," 2 Corinthians 9:15

Paul is expressing gratitude to God for the ultimate gift of Jesus Christ, highlighting how generous and beyond human comprehension God's gift of salvation is, while also encouraging the Corinthians to give generously to those in need, mirroring God's own giving nature.

Indescribable gift:

This refers to the gift of Jesus Christ, which is so great and beyond human understanding that words cannot fully capture its value.

Context of giving:

This verse comes within a larger passage where Paul is urging the Corinthian church to generously contribute to the needs of the poor believers in Jerusalem.

Connection to generosity:

By emphasizing the "indescribable gift" of Jesus, Paul is encouraging the Corinthians to also give generously, reflecting God's abundant love and grace

A gentle reminder of the most wondrous Christmas gift ever bestowed: it was from God Himself, in the form of His son, Jesus Christ. Embracing this divine offering grants us the promise of eternal life.
