
COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR





Per our P&P, here is what's supposed to happen next for those newly elected members.

4.2.3 ORIENTATION OF NEW SECRETARIAT MEMBERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRANSITIONING SECRETARIAT MEMBERS: To facilitate the orientation of new secretariat members, a proscribed orientation period shall be established including the following components: A. Upon valid election to the secretariat during the June sequela, incoming secretariat members shall attend the June and following secretariat meetings to begin to

familiarize themselves with the functions and expectations within the secretariat meetings. New members are encouraged to engage the discussions with their opinions, ideas, and thoughts while the outgoing members mentor the incoming cohort. Although voting rights shall not be conferred until the January of the year following their election.

B. The Secretary shall provide new members with an orientation packet including, but not

limited to, the current NFTD By-Laws, the NFTD Policies and Practices Manual, the Tres Dias Essentials, Pescadores Orientation materials, and any other relevant documentation.

These materials should also include the specific responsibilities and role descriptions. C.

Newly elected members are required to attend the earliest available Pescadore

Orientation immediately following the June sequela. If the newly elected member is
unable to attend the first available opportunity, he or she must notify the chairperson as
soon as possible and make arrangements to attend the next scheduled opportunity. D.
Newly elected members shall observe and increasingly assume the responsibilities of the
position being assumed. The outgoing members should provide regular training, gradually
transition responsibilities of the position to prepare the newly elected member to assume
the full responsibilities of the role by January of their first full year of service. E. During

the first six months the newly elected members having fully assumed the role, the

outgoing members will serve in an advisory capacity.

Practical Pronouncements from the Pre-Weekend Couple

Just as the writer of 3 John 1:2 states, we greet you by saying, "Dear friend[s], [we] hope all is well with you and that you are as healthy in body as you are strong in spirit" (NLT). As you are considering potential sponsorship for the upcoming NFTD Weekend #68, we ask that you not only share the highlights of the incredible encounters that your applicant will no doubt experience throughout their three days, but also share that this can be a time of refinement for them as well. John 15:1-2 says, "I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn't produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more" (NLT). We know that overgrowth can often stagnate fruitfu

lness and regular maintenance, or pruning, is sometimes needed in order for vegetation to yield an even more bountiful product or harvest.

Encourage your candidate to be open to this time of refinement, as the Lord may want to cut away those things that could be preventing your candidate

from producing an even more fruitful harvest in his/her own life.
