
TREASURER

Greetings from deep in the NFTD Bank Vault!

With the Men's and Women's weekend fast approaching I have some recommendations on how those serving on a team can help defray costs.

- 1. If you are a hot drink drinker, bring a mug or reusable drink container with you. This saves hundreds of dollar\$ on Styrofoam cups. Do not bring a previous weekend mug though as this may give away one of the surprises that the Candidates may receive in their Palanca Bag.
- 2. If you are not a hot drink drinker, same, bring a reusable container for your cold drinks. We will still provide the ice... as much as you can handle.
- 3. If you do need to use a Styrofoam cup, put your name on it and reuse it. Get out of the habit of using a new cup for each drink. Stop it. I mean it, stop it!!
- 4. Generally, if you don't really need it, just don't use it... no matter what it may be. I raised my family with a phrase that I learned: Use it up, wear it out, make it do, do without.

the path.


