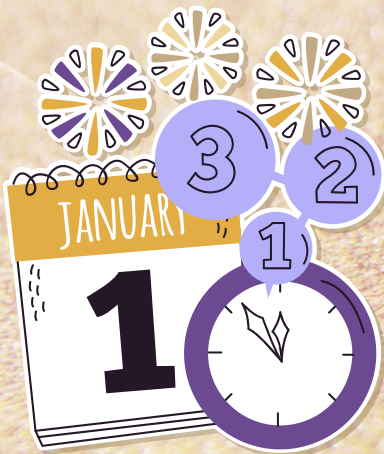


PESCADORE ORIENTATION COORDINATOR

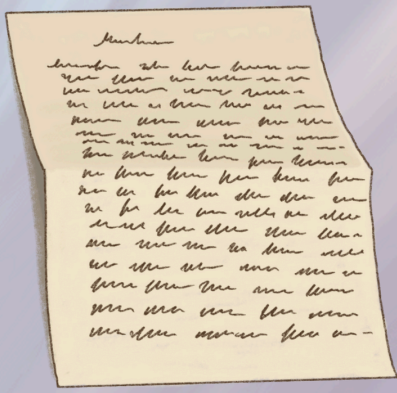

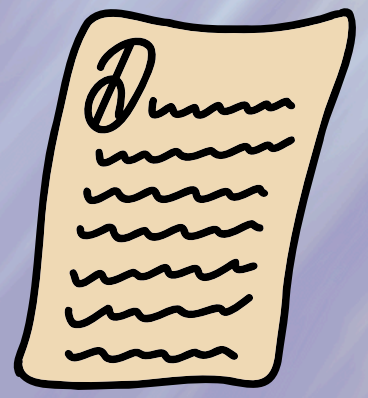

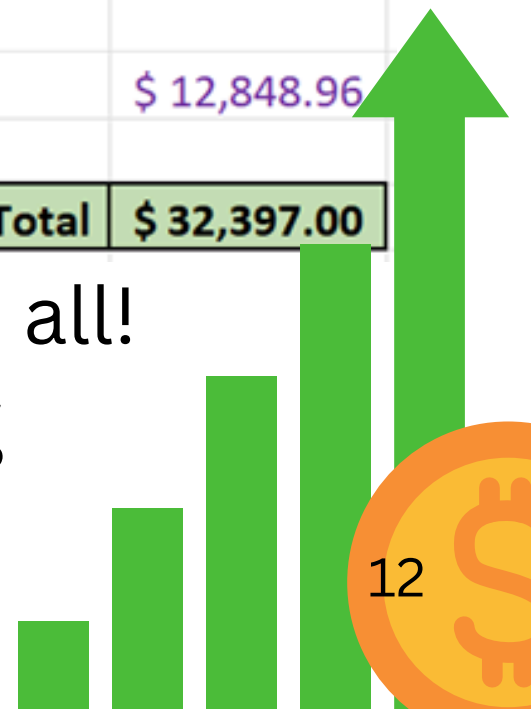

**The Lord directs our steps, so why try to understand
Everything along the way?**

Proverbs 20:24

It is so amazing how God will take something little and turn it into a message. After fishing for a few hours and had not caught anything, we decided to head back in. On the way back we a seen a good bit of boats in this area so we decided to stop and try to see if we could catch a few fish. We dropped the anchor, but it would not keep us where we were trying to fish. We kept moving back to where we were trying to fish but the wind and current kept pushing us away. After about three time of doing this, We decided to just stay where the water was taking us and we just tied of to this pole, within just a few minutes we got a bite, we would reel it in, throw the line back and got another bite! this when on for about a hour. As I'm sitting there God tells me “ I was trying to show yall where the fish where but yall wouldn't not listen.”

It was a humbling reminder that sometimes, despite our best efforts and intentions, we need to let go and trust in God. The experience was not just about catching fish, it was about learning to be still and listen, to be open to guidance that may not always align with our initial expectations. As we sat there, surrounded by the gentle rocking of the boat and the serene beauty of nature, we realized that life is often like this fishing trip. We may have our own ideas about where we want to go and how we want things to happen, but sometimes, it's in the unexpected detours that we find the most rewarding outcomes. This lesson has stayed with us, reminding us to remain patient and receptive to the directions we are given, even when they lead us away from our original plans. Through this, we found joy, abundance, and a deeper sense of faith, knowing that we are never truly adrift when we allow ourselves to be guided.
