Brothers and sisters:





PREWEEKEND COUPLE

Have you ever thought about what it means to be a leader in the Tres Dias Community? According to a position paper located on the Tres Dias International website, a Community Leader is a person who is "active within the Tres Dias ministry. This includes clergy and laity, all team positions and all Secretariat positions; including voting and committee roles."

So, what then are the qualifications for serving as a leader in a Tres Dias Community? Well, according to the same position paper, the qualifications for Community Leadership are defined as follows:

Any person serving in a Community Leadership position must be living a life that is not in a state of rebellion against God. A state of rebellion against God can best be described as an unrepentant, open and active participation in or advocacy of activities contrary to the commands (for example, "The TEN COMMANDMENTS") and guidelines in Scripture for holy living and Christian leadership.

Reflecting on the statements above, a Community Leader is a person who should be living a life that reflects holy living, as outlined in the Scriptures. Jesus calls us to live a life that is holy because we CAN live a life of holiness. We can do so because Holy Spirit lives out His life in and through us. We just have to be willing to yield to Him. And, this applies to us at all times, not just when we are serving on a Tres Dias Weekend.

So, what does a life of holiness look like? Here are a few scriptures, which can provide some insight here and now. But, we encourage you also to also explore God's Word and allow Him to highlight some areas of holiness He may want to work out in your own life:

Hebrews 12:14 (NIV) says, "Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness, no one will see the Lord."

1 Peter 1:15 – 16 (ESV) says, "But as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, 'You shall be holy, for I am holy."

1 Timothy 4:12 (NIV) says, "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity."

Philippians 2:14-16 (ESV) says, "Do all things without grumbling or disputing, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ, I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain."

As leaders in this community and elsewhere, we are called to do things in, and with, excellence. We won't always get it right, but are we willing to take an honest look at how we live our lives and make intentional strides towards a life of holiness that is reflected in all that we say and do?

We'll leave you with a concluding statement that is also found within the same document mentioned earlier: "In order to carry out the mission and ministry of Tres Dias, we must hold to and model the principles and precepts of Christ and His Word. We cannot teach what we do not live."
