### SOUND EQUIPMENT PROPOSAL

Hello community. As I have mentioned before, the sound equipment at the campground needs to be replaced. We have been through several vendors and evaluated many estimates and the ones below are the best we have seen so far. While we are several months away from our next sets of weekends in October, we need to start the replacement process of the existing equipment.

I am presenting these quotes for your prayers, thoughtful considerations and if so led, your donations. I have separated the quotes into the various areas of usage, and I rounded up the costs because prices can vary depending on when we order the equipment. The expert that guided us said that this equipment could last us for many years to come.

Dining Hall (used for candidate's reception, dining announcements, serenades, and other functions):

1 soundboard	\$ 930
2 ten-inch powered speakers (indoor type)	\$700
Cables, odds and ends, contingency	\$ 370
Total: \$2,000.00	

Chapel (chapel services and Closings):

1 soundboard	\$ 930
1 wedge monitor eight-inch powered speaker,	\$800
2 ten-inch powered speakers (indoor/outdoor, high quality)	\$1,800
Cables, odds and ends, contingency	\$ 370

Total: \$3,900.00

#### Rollo Room (rollos, praise and worship, etc.):

1 soundboard	\$ 930
1 wedge monitor eight-inch powered speaker	\$800
2 ten-inch powered speakers (indoor/outdoor, high quality)	\$1,800
2 eight-inch powered speakers (auxiliary chapel and porch)	\$500
Cables, odds and ends, contingency	\$ 380

Total: \$4,410.00



## PREWEEKEND COUPLE

Now that the Spring 2025 North Florida Tres Dias Weekends are over, you may be thinking, "Well, what's next?" Next, we enter into the Post Weekend phase of Tres Dias. In the description below, we will outline what the Post Weekend phase consists of, according to the NFTD Policies and Practices Manual (2025):

The purpose of the Post Weekend phase of TRES DIAS is to assist the Pescadore in all phases of their growth in the Lord, including their personal relationship with the Lord Jesus, their individual study, and their action within their family, their church, the TRES DIAS Community, and the rest of their environment. One part of the individual's growth and development is by encouraging the Pescadore to set their own individual goals and objectives, and then to find someone to relate to, with whom the individual feels comfortable, and to whom they are able to become accountable. It is the purpose of reunion groups to foster this process. Other vehicles for individual growth and development of the Pescadores within the structure of TRES DIAS include the Sequela, and participating in additional Weekends as a Team Member. Resources for assisting the Pescadores in each of these areas include the Fourth Day Couple, the Men's and Women's Leaders, and the Community Spiritual Director. It is strongly suggested that the Pescadore become familiar with and utilize the resources of their own church to the full extent possible in addition to
