Virtue: positive traits to practice compassion, kindness, humility, and forgiveness. Apostle Paul positions Love as the most important element that unites all other virtues.

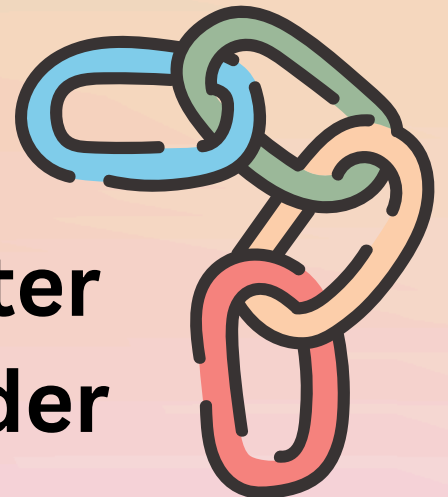
Bond: Love is described as the glue that perfectly holds a Community and its values together.
