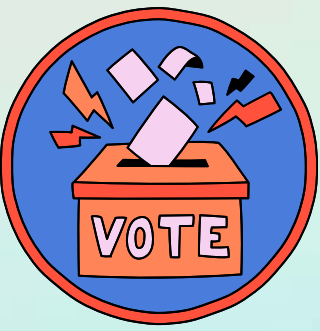

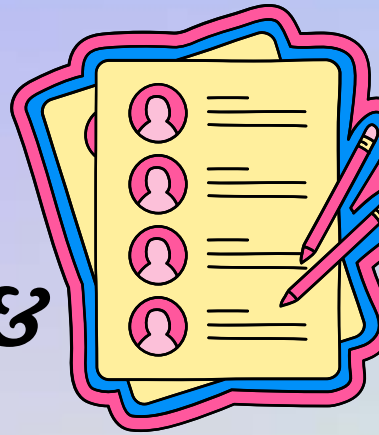

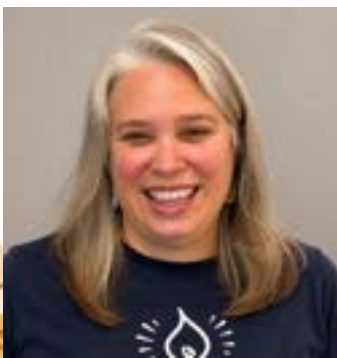
Thank you to everyone who attended Pescadore Orientation! We are so grateful for your willingness to learn, serve, and be part of what God is doing through Tres Dias.
