## Where Is Your Focus?

"But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, 'Lord, save me!' Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. 'You of little faith,' he said, 'why did you doubt?' And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down." Matthew 14:30-32

God wants us to walk in faith. You might think that when Jesus told Peter to come out of the boat and walk on water that He would keep the water still to make it as easy as possible, but that's not how He works. Peter got out and the wind got stronger leaving Peter a choice to either keep his eyes on Jesus or to give in to the fear of self preservation and look at the wind. Clearly the wind was under the Lord's control because as soon as they got to the boat it stopped. The test was then over, Peter got rebuked for his lack of faith, but he was no worse for the wear for going through it. It wasn't really about life or death as Peter might have thought, it was just a test.

Just like clockwork - as the weekends approach, Satan seems to hit the team, candidates and their families with all sorts of unforseen challenges. How does God look at our present difficulties and challenges? He could easily solve every problem we are facing right now, but He's trying to build our faith.
