REPORTS

1. Financial Report, Sean Nyberg, Treasurer

Sean presented the financial report which consisted of the following: Operations Account - \$12,430.76 Procurement Account- \$1,564.78, Fourth Day Account - \$1,000.91, Food Account - \$1,348.27, Savings Account - \$11,000.70, Total Accounts at Synovus - \$27,345.42, Calton Investment Emergency Fund - \$13,348.44, Grand Total - \$40,693.86. Recent bills paid were the NFTD Annual Assessment of \$765.00 and Philadelphia Insurance of \$1,299.87. Sean advised he paid the Zoom account for one year which was \$159.00 and is now available for use.

2. Weekend #70 Reports

- **Kay King, Women's Leader-** Kay said the planning is going great and she is so proud of Fay. She deferred to Fay Steele-Rector for upcoming for Women's Weekend #70. Fay said all of the team meetings have been Holy Ghost and Holy Spirit led. She has 92 team applications. September 20th will be the short script reading and Becky will do a PO training also after the meeting. Everyone on the women's and men's team that need PO have been notified. We have had two meetings so far and it is very evident that the Holy Spirit is there.
- **Bruce King, Men's Leader** - Bruce deferred to Terry Pafford-Rector for upcoming Men's Weekend #70. Terry said the men have had two meetings so far. Everything is going amazing. The talks are falling into place.

2. Sound System - Chad Slayton gave everyone a new updated quote provided by Phoenix Gibson which has decreased from the previous one. The quote was \$5,200 and the new quote is \$4,597.95. This quote is for the Rollo Room equipment only. Andy Fowler informed everyone that we received a trailer from Ron Walsh and Dude Settergren wants to purchase the trailer for \$5,000.00. That money would come back into Tres Dias. Andy reminded us again that Eric Chandler offered a climate controlled building that we could store the new equipment in if needed. Rodney Whitfield was concerned about whoever replaces the current Procurement Couple and the Weekend Couple whether their truck would be able to pull the trailer with added weight. There is a possibility that both trailers can be combined. If we are trying to combine both trailers, Rodney suggested selling one. Rodney made a motion to sell the extra trailer given to us by Ron Walsh to Dude Settergren for \$5,000.00. Sean Nyberg second the motion. All agreed on the motion. Sean Nyberg made a motion to purchase the new sound system for \$4,597.95 with Phoenix Gibson installing and training on how to use the equipment. Chad Slayton second the motion. All agreed.
3. Selection Committee for PO Replacement - Kay King advised the Selection Committee voted on Wayne and Brittani Stallings as the new PO Couple to start in 2026.

NEW BUSINESS

1. SD - Mike Albritton - Mike wanted to remind everyone that Tres Dias is an Essentials, and Ecumenical movement. In past weekends, teams and candidates have been prayed over by the prayer team and at times the prayers would not stop until they felt that person was healed. His concern is that this may deter team members from coming back and serve and prevent them from sending candidates through. Another situation that happened was someone clapping to bring out demons. Mike said in good faith he could not sponsor people with these things going on and it has to be stopped immediately and dealt with. Something like this could also affect a person's faith. He

suggested the corrections need to start with the Men's and Women's leaders. As a community, the list to attend Tres Dias has dwindled down tremendously. He remembers when there was a waiting list. He also added that the spiritual leaders need to be from different churches and to involve new pastors as much as we can. This needs to be addressed through communication, training, and awareness. Mike wanted to ensure that all denominations were represented on a Tres Dias weekend and that not any one denomination was being promoted.

Kyle Moye said he has reached out to several pastors to serve and gets the runaround. There are going to be mishaps on every weekend and we need not to get offended. It is important for us to teach and raise up Christian leaders.

Rodney Whitfield said anything spiritual needs to be handled by the spiritual leaders only.

Jen Hamilton said she shares with candidates of over 100 churches that they may see things that are different sometimes. People that get in those specific moments Mike mentioned needs to be addressed at that time.

The question was asked who was responsible when things like this happen on a weekend. Fay Steele said in Policy and Procedures 2.2 it states that the Rector is given full authority of the weekend. She said when these things happen we should use that as a training and teaching moment and also use the Chain of Command.

Betty Lou Calloway said she was present during the situation Mike was referring to but walked away. She will get with Kay King and tell her about the situation because Kay was not aware.

Felisha Mitchell said sometimes people are going to do what they want to. We just need to train and educate.
