**Approval / Corrections of August 2025 Minutes** - Cindy read minutes out loud. No corrections were mentioned. Minutes stand as is.

## **REPORTS**

### **1. Financial Report, Sean Nyberg, Treasurer**

Sean presented the financial report which consisted of the following: Operations Account - \$24,745.14 Procurement Account- \$553.83, Fourth Day Account - \$770.86, Food Account - \$1,348.27, Savings Account - \$11,000.75, Total Accounts at Synovus - \$34,418.85 Calton Investment Emergency Fund - \$13,413.58, Grand Total - \$51,832.43. Recent bills paid were the Philadelphia Insurance-Liability Policy of \$1,299.87, Constant Contact-\$62.00, Sweetwater Sound Systems (new soundboards and speakers) \$4,823.24, and Sweetwater Sound Systems (two new soundboards) \$2,099.96. Sean said the new sound equipment has been put together and tested with everything working great. One of the existing soundboards is still not repaired, the other is very old. Now all soundboards are the same and under a two year warranty. The trailer that Dude purchased was for \$6,000.00 instead of \$5,000.00. Upcoming large expenses are Men's food bill, Men's campground expense, Men's send off expenses, Women's food bill, Women's campground expense, and Women's send off expenses.

### **2. Weekend #70 Reports**

- **Kay King, Women's Leader-** Kay said Fay is doing a fantastic job. She deferred to Fay Steele-Rector for upcoming for Women's Weekend #70. Fay said she has an awesome team. She found herself letting go of control due to having such an amazing team. The talks have been amazing and she has 88 team members at this time.
- **Bruce King, Men's Leader** - Bruce deferred to Terry Pafford-Rector for upcoming Men's Weekend #70. Terry said the Short script reading was done on Thursday. He has 82 team members at this time and he is ready.

### **3. Pre-Weekend, Jason & Jen Hamilton**

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Jen said she has received 22 men candidate applications with 11 confirmed and 30 women candidate applications with 15 confirmed at this time. There are nine single ladies waiting to be added to the list once all married couples have been confirmed.

#### **4. Sequela, Kyle & Stephanie Hatcher**

Stephanie said the next sequela will be on September 27 at ALBB in Cairo. This sequela will be Family Fun Day. She also stated that on the women's weekend there will be a QR code for the Facebook page, NFTD page, TDI Facebook page, and the Roster for all contacts.

#### **5. Other Member Reports**

- Newsletter Couple - Aaron reminded everyone their newsletters are due on the 25th. He said they currently have seven submissions and need 10 more. We have three days to get them turned in...so let's go.
- Procurement Couple - Amanda said the music and totes have all been put into one trailer.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

1. Updated Books for Sections - Kristin Bailey said she, Chris Farney, Mary Bailey, Kay King, and Annie Tillman have been in contact with both Rectors for any changes that need to be changed in the Head's books after the weekend. She said immediately after the Women's weekend, the committee will begin updating the Head's books. Kristen presented changes concerning Equivalent Weekends on Policy & Procedures and Bylaws that need to be revised. A motion was made by Sean Nyberg to listen and discuss if needed to the suggested changes and incorporate the suggested changes. Rodney Whitfield second the motion. All agreed  
Kristin also states that in the Bylaws a Handbook 1.1.1 is mentioned and no one knew what the Handbook was. Rodney made a motion to remove the wording of Handbook 1.1.1 from anywhere in the P & P and Bylaws. Jessica Whitfield second the motion. All agreed
2. Pescadore Orientation - Becky Strahan - Becky said PO was held on 09/20/25 with 19 in attendance. This should take care of anyone needing PO before the upcoming weekend. Becky said if anyone is added to the team that has not attended a PO, an email can be sent to qualify them with the intention of them attending a PO in 2026. She said she communicated with Fay and Terry on PO attendance over the past few months. According to Policies and Procedures 2.2 F it says when a Pescadore is asked by the Rector to serve, they should have attended or plan to attend PO. This is now required. A list of potential teams that has not achieved a PO, should be given to the Chairman and

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Mens/Womens Leader. She asked for clarification for the PO budget which is \$100.00. Sean said that was correct and was for each year. When PO needs paper goods, may they ask the Fourth Day or Food Couple for them. That answer was yes. She said that we have a drawing at the two mandatory PO's before each weekend for team fees. It was discussed about a link that anyone needing PO could go that would provide a video with questions to be answered afterwards. Wayne & Brittani Stallings, the upcoming new PO couple, said they can create a link on Youtube for future training.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Bank Changes - Sean Nyberg - Sean said currently we have four debit cards. He is recommending that we change to credit cards for each section that needs one. Also these credit cards will receive cash back and a level of points which is better. The cards will come with fraud protection and will be linked to the social security number of the person using the card.  
Jessica Whitfield explained that card users are under an umbrella corporation which is a non profit so a guarantor is not needed. The points can be used for Amazon cards of cash back to pay the bill. She said that there will be a 3% charge for using the cards. Sean Nyberg made a motion to have Synovus Bank change our debit cards to a small business travel reward card to include us providing the minutes which would transfer responsibility from an individual to a corporation. Amanda Slayton second the motion. All agreed
2. Pregnant Women Going on the Weekend - Mike Albritton - Mike has a couple from his church that want to go through this upcoming weekend. The wife is 22 weeks pregnant and her husband will be deployed after this weekend. Mike said the wife was told that she could not go through. He was asking if there was a rule concerning this. There had been some questions and concerns in the past about a woman that was pregnant going on the weekend and possibly being a liability. Whether it would be safe for her and the concern that the closest hospital was 45 minutes to an hour away. **Carrie Pafford** said that really any medical condition is a liability but we allow them to attend. So there should not be any reason that we would not allow a pregnant woman to attend. The mother also needs to understand that the closest hospital is 45 minutes to an hour away and allow them to make that decision of where they will attend or not. **Jessica Whitfield** said this is where self determination should be used. In the Essentials 3.2, it states that "the freedom of self-determination of each candidate should be respected." **Kristin Bailey** added that the cut off for adding new candidates is one week before the weekend begins.
