## **WELCOME / LIGHTING OF CANDLE / OPENING PRAYER / DEVOTION / COMMUNION**

Chairman, Andy Fowler called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Kyle Moye shared devotion. John 15:12 - 13 "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." Our goal should be to love and unify one another. We need to focus on loving and helping one another, not on offense. Love is bigger than any situation.

## **MINUTES**

The minutes may reflect the actual sequence of events as discussed rather than the original agenda order.

**Approval / Corrections of September 2025 Minutes** - Kristin read minutes out loud. One change is needed to New Business #1. There is not a 3% charge for using the cards. There is up to 3% cash back. Minutes pending this change were approved. Sean Nyberg motioned, Jessica Whitfield seconded, all approved.

## **REPORTS**

### **1. Financial Report, Sean Nyberg, Treasurer**

Sean presented the financial report which consisted of the following: Operations Account - \$10,294.01, Procurement Account - \$1,093.78, Fourth Day Account - \$1,008.97, Food Account - \$1,079.18, Savings Account - \$1,000.78, CD - \$10,000.00, Total Accounts at Synovus - \$24,476.72, Calton Investment Emergency Fund - \$13,415.51, Grand Total - \$37,892.23. Recent bills paid were Men's Weekend Campground - \$6,093.00, Women's Weekend - campground - \$6,715.00, Men's Weekend Food - \$5,035.89, Women's Weekend Food - \$2,948.80, Weekend - ACV Village Store - \$237.86.

The \$10,000 was moved to a CD earning 4%. These funds can be accessed when needed.

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## **2. Weekend #70 Reports**

- **Kay King, Women's Leader-** Kay said the weekend was awesome. Fay shared that she couldn't thank the Lord enough for being in control. It was one of the most Spirit filled weekends she has ever experienced.
- **Bruce King, Men's Leader** - Bruce and Terry shared that 22 men's lives were changed forever. It was a great and amazing weekend.

## **3. Pre-Weekend, Jason & Jen Hamilton**

No updates at this time. Transitioning from Jen and Jason to Annie and Wendall Tillman.

## **4. Sequela Update, Kyle & Stephanie Hatcher**

The victory sequela will be November 8th at First Baptist Church in Thomasville at 5 P.M. They could use volunteers for worship for sequelas.

## **5. Other Member Reports**

- Food Couple - \$6,300.44 - men, \$3,952.88 - women, Total \$10,253.32. Only \$134.59 spent on special diet. 1890 meals were served at \$5.43 per meal.
- Newsletter couple - not in attendance, but please submit articles.
- Weekend Couple - The new sound equipment worked really well. A part has been received to repair one of the old systems so that there will be backups on the trailer. Vic Parramore is going to test it out.
- PO - Last PO was in September, Becky is meeting with Wayne and Brittany Stallings to transition. A copy of the training manual should be given to the Secretary.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

1. Updated Books for Sections - Kristin shared that the committee will be meeting on November 3rd to work on the updated head books for all sections. Chris and Scott Farney, Mary Bailey, Kelly Quinn, and Kristin are on the committee.

Kristin also presented minor revisions to the Policies and Practices and Bylaws. Bylaws changes, 6.9.2 Secretary - add that the secretary serves on the Executive Committee and Rules Committee, 6.9.3 Treasurer - add that Treasurer serves on the Executive Committee and Rules Committee, 6.9.4 Men's/Women's Leader - Add that they serve on

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the Executive and Selection Committee. Policies and Practices - Section 2.4 stated that the Head Spiritual Director shall have served on at least 3 weekends as spiritual director. Section 2.2D said the Head Spiritual Director for the weekend will have served on at least four previous weekends as a spiritual director. Kyle shared that the Spiritual Director manual says that the Head Spiritual Director should have been a Rookie once and Middle twice for a total of 3. Kyle can provide the language from the spiritual director book. The Rules Committee should meet to discuss the protocol for spiritual directors that may have served in other communities. Each community structure is different so we would likely need information from the other community on a case by case basis.

Rodney made a motion to change language in both Section 2.4 and 2.2D to "Head Spiritual Director shall have served on at least 3 weekends including having served in the position of Rookie Spiritual Director once and Middle Spiritual Director twice. These weekends will have been served in North Florida Tres Dias. If the Spiritual Director is from another community, eligibility will be evaluated on a case by case basis." Sean Nyberg seconded, all were in favor.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Procurement Couple - Kerri and Ken Bennett would like to be considered. The Selection Committee will discuss in January.
2. NFTD #70 issues and adjustments for #71.

Women's - 2 people went home. One was sick and one did not like the music and prayer.

Men's - May need reminders that the silent retreat is for both team and candidates. Tobacco (specifically smoking/vaping) use everywhere, not in designated spots. The campground has rules regarding smoking areas and we need to abide by those. One person broke cloister, he knew the boundaries. The perimeters of the campground need to be taught at team meetings and at team chapel on the weekend. A visual map of the perimeters will be created and added to section head books. This map should be presented at the November Secretariat meeting.

Andy presented an issue:

On the men's weekend a few of the men serving in chapel were talking with the ladies during serenade. The chapel section book should state that no men/women should be in chapel with the opposite sex. The chapel chas should

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follow the candidates in. This needs to be added to the short script as well. This was discussed in the March 2024 compliance paperwork, but needs to be incorporated into the other documents. The generic scripts need to be obtained from the men's and women's leaders.
