Treasurer, Sean Nyberg called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

MINUTES

The minutes may reflect the actual sequence of events as discussed rather than the original agenda order.

REPORTS:

- 1. Financial Report, Sean Nyberg, Treasure**
- 2. Weekend**
 - **Women's Leader, Janet Lancaster:** It was discussed that new applications for weekend #71 would need to be submitted and that they would be open beginning on April 28th
 - **Men's Leader, Bruce King:** New applications would not be needed for the entirety of team for weekend #71
- 3. Pre-Weekend, Wendell & Annie Tillman:** Annie stated that she has contacted all approved candidates and sponsors to let them know that they were good for the fall. They have received no new applications.
- 4. Newsletter, Aaron & Iris Loudermilk:** Secretariat members were given their friendly reminder to turn in their April articles by the deadline.
- 5. Palanca, Rodney & Jessica Whitfield:** Jessica asked that the clipboards given to the Men's and Women's teams be returned so that they prayer scroll could be re-done for October,

Communion: Sean Nyberg requested that we enter into a time of communion, Rodney Whitfield prayed and all who were present took part.

Old Business:

1. Team Book: Sean Nyberg asked those who were assigned a specific book, to please finish that and get it to Kristen. Annie Tillman pointed out that some who were assigned books are no longer part of the Secretariat. Sean Nyberg stated that Kristen had the list and would redistribute to those remaining in order to complete the project.

New Business:

1. Resignations: Sean Nyberg that while some may be aware, some may not be, in regards to several resignations from the Secretariat. He stated that we have to determine what we will do in regard to filling those positions. The emergency meeting held via Zoom was mentioned and that the Secretariat came up with a short application for wanting to serve on the Secretariat. We as the Secretariate agreed it would help keep order to the

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process which is different than filling positions due to rolling off. Jessica Whitfield read off the items on the application that need to be completed. Janet Lancaster asked where the application could be found. Sean stated they will have it on the website and Facebook. Iris Loudermilk asked where they needed to be sent. If filled out on the website they will go to Kristen Bailey, if emailed they will go to Kristen or Jessica Whitfield. Jason Stanley asked if it would be used to nominate someone for a position that is rolling off. Sean stated that since we so many vacant positions, that yes we would do this for both. Lisa Bennett asked for verification on how we would be voting to fill the vacancies, and it was stated that the positions being filled due to resignations are vote on by the Secretariat and would be posted in the Newsletter. The process for those rolling off would be handled by the Selection Committee and voted on by the Community in June. Rodney Whitfield discussed the key positions that we really needed to focus on. Mark Savage spoke up about concerns regarding Kristen Bailey being in the Chairman position since she has not been a Rector. Jessica Whitfield stated that in the By Laws/Policies and Procedures that the Secretary steps in until we replace them. That in this situation qualifications are not what we go by, she also stated that it was recommended by our International Liaison that she remain on through the end of the year, so we can focus on the other positions and bringing unity to the Community.

2. Logistics for Resignation/term limits: Annie Tillman brought up instituting a process of term for oncoming members due to resignation, i.e.: if resignation is during the first year the oncoming member only completes the remaining term or if it is at the end, they complete the term and the following 3 year commitment. It was brought up that the Procurement Couple is on a second term, Sean Nyberg explained that it was the discretion of the Secretariat and the Slaytons. Jessica Whitfield stated that it was also discussed, should anyone come forward they would vacate and train the new couple at the time, not at the end of the 3 year term.
3. Coordination of Community Communication: It was discussed that while we use the newsletter, PO, Facebook, and Sequelas, we can't seem to get the information out to the Community as a whole. Sean Nyberg stated that he could see through the Constant Contact application the amount of people who opened the email with the newsletter and who actually clicked on it. Sean suggested that we reach out to people who we haven't seen in a while. Jessica Whitfield stated that it comes back to sponsorship. Sponsorship doesn't end at closing, so are you calling those you sponsored to let them know about sequelas, secretariat meetings, etc., because that is how you get new people involved. It was asked how you can sign up to get the newsletter, and it was stated that you do that through the website. Mary Bailey pointed out that it would be good that you keep in contact with those at your table for at least a year. Jessica Whitfield stated that we also need to remember that Tres Dias is a tool to build leaders to go back to their church, that some people aren't called to come back and serve and that is ok. Randy Carlton stated that when he called to check on people, that they stated they had other things going on but were glad he checked in. Before moving on, Sean

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Nyberg asked Annie to type up a proposal for the Secretariat to review. Sean recapped the avenues of how we can communicate with the Community.

4. Sequelas: Sean Nyberg suggests that we table this until later all agreed, however Hunter brought up an opportunity for the Community to serve and gather for Praise, Prayer and Plates on Saturday, April 25th. Sean asked Hunter to email him details for it to be added to the newsletter. It was stated that we still plan to have the May 9th sequela since it is already in place.

5. Applications for Secretariat Positions and Timing of reopening Weekend #71 applications: There was a recap of the positions needed, and that they would be listed in the newsletter with details of whether it was a couple or a single. Earlier in the meeting it was stated by Janet Lancaster that applications for the Women's Weekend would open back up on April 28th.

Sean Nyberg asked if anyone on the Secretariat had anything, not discussed already, to bring up. Rodney Whitfield asked if we could take names for positions and it was answered with a no, Iris asked if they could write it down and again the answer was no, the application was the method. After this some of the community asked questions regarding various things related to Tres Dias.

Sean Nyberg closed out the regular meeting with prayer.
