WELCOME / LIGHTING OF CANDLE / OPENING PRAYER / DEVOTION / COMMUNION

Chairman, Kristin Bailey called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Approval / Corrections of May 2026 Minutes: The table said they reviewed the minutes with no corrections. Minutes were approved with no corrections or changes.

REPORTS:

1. Financial Report, Sean Nyberg, Treasurer:

Operating account - \$16,363.67, Procurement account- \$1,003.78, Fourth Day account - \$841.87, Food account - \$1,002.94, CD (4% at maturity) - \$10,000.00, Emergency Fund - \$13,808.40, Total Synovus - \$29,212.26, Grand Total - \$43,020.66. Sean mentioned the paid expenses were for the June Sequela in the amount of \$100.00.

2. Upcoming Weekend #71:

Women's Leader, Janet Lancaster: Deferred to Kristin Bailey, Rector for Women's Weekend #71: Kristin said things are going well. Kristin said the Heads and Professors meeting will be on 06/27/26. She has all heads in place and will be calling the rest of the team. She has 55-60 team applications but need more to complete the team. Team meetings will begin on 08/08/26.

Men's Leader, Bruce King: Deferred to Randy Carlton, Rector for Men's Weekend #71: Randy said he has 80-85 team members. The Heads and Professors meeting will be on 07/18/26. The team meetings will begin on 08/22/26.

Kristin advised the next PO will be on 08/15/26 at Seminole Baptist Church in Tallahassee, Florida from 9:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m.

3. Pre-Weekend, Wendell & Annie Tillman: Annie said she has six candidate applications from the Spring. She will begin calling on those and new applications in August.

4. Sequelas: Sequela was held on 06/13/26 at Seminole Baptist Church in Tallahassee, Florida with 49 in attendance

5. Newsletter, Aaron & Iris Loudermilk: They were not present at the meeting.

6. Other Member Reports: Chad mentioned that he was meeting with Adrienne Carson's fiancé's company about possibly tinting the windows in the Chapel at the campground.

Old Business:

1: Constant Contact: Chris Sham is working on modifications. Sean mentioned the newsletter stats are still the same as last month. He has spoken with an Integrated data base out of St. Louis who provides software that can help the community be managed in real time. The cost would be \$350.00 for the first year and \$500.00 after that. Sean said he would set up a Zoom meeting for training on the data base.

New Business:

1: Community Voting Process for New Secretariat Members - Kristin mentioned about blending the resignation vs the normal process. She asked do we need to be voted on by the community after the names have been posted? She suggested to vote as we have been voting at the June Sequela. She spoke with Frank and he is still getting phone calls from the community advising some are still not happy with the voting process. Denny Farkas suggested the community needs to feel like they have a voice. Denny suggested to Kristin that we have ballots with names and everyone gets a vote of either Yes or No. The Selection Committee will count the votes at the June Annual Meeting (Sequela) by voting on only one name from the ballot for each position. Kristin will announce how and who will be on the ballot and you must be present to vote. She will post this process in the Newsletter and on the Official NFTD Facebook page. Denny mentioned that he and the Executive Committee will try to solve the calls going to TDI from the community.

2: Questions on Team and Candidate Applications: Annie mentioned the five questions on the applications. She asked if people would be honest. It was mentioned that TDI asked those same five questions for accountability not legalism. Chris Sham reminded us of the Statement of Faith. Annie made a motion that the Position Paper from TDI be removed along with the five questions and replaced with a Statement of Belief to acknowledge they are living a Christian lifestyle and be added to the candidate along with the team application. Sean second the motion. All agreed.

3: Proxy Vote on International Ballot for the July Annual Meeting: The TDI FY2027 Budget was sent out this week for proxy voting. Kristin read the proxy and budget proposal for TDI. The new budget was \$78,710. All voted and agreed.

4: July Secretariat Meeting: Kristin asked if the Secretariat wanted to have a Secretariat meeting in July. All voted yes. The July meeting will be on 07/27/26 at Crossroads Church in Beachton, Georgia.

Chris Sham mentioned that Judy Daughty asked to be reclassified from Clergy to Lay Person. She was voted by $\frac{3}{4}$ of the table. Chris will notify her of this change.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:08 p.m with Chris Sham doing the closing prayer.
